**IMPORTANT: WEBSITE USE FOR TENNIS RESERVATIONS**

We have a CCRA website-based tennis reservation system. Please be sure that you check the website, [www.chevychaserec.org](http://www.chevychaserec.org), and that you keep your email and contact information updated with the CCRA business office, [chevychaserec@msn.com](mailto:chevychaserec@msn.com). You may also update your profile directly on the website.

You must sign in to the member side of the website to make tennis reservations **no earlier than 8:00 AM** the day prior to play. Please indicate how many guests you will have and/or which members will play with you. Further rules for making tennis reservations are on the "Book a Court" link of the website. When entering the court enclosure, each playing member must scan his or her magnetic card and sign in the registration book. You must be a Permanent member or Full Summer family to utilize the reservation service year-round. Combination and Partial Summer families may use the reservation service beginning on Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup>. Weekday and Combination families may use any vacant court on weekdays during their weekday only use period beginning Tuesday, May 30<sup>th</sup>. Combination use may begin using the courts on Weekends on Saturday, July 29<sup>th</sup>.

**2017 STINGRAYS SWIM TEAM UPDATE**

The 2017 Stingrays will be swimming in Division "J" of the Montgomery County Swim League (MCSL) this season. For 2017, the Stingrays welcome two new coaches: Head Coach Jack Leavitt and Assistant Head Coach Laura McGlaughlin. The Stingrays have two components: swim team is for any swimmer who can swim the length of the pool in any stroke, and pre-team is for 8 and under swimmers who can swim half the length of the pool, but cannot yet swim the full length of the pool. Swim season kicks off with team practice starting Tuesday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, and pre-team practice beginning Monday, June 19<sup>th</sup>. Time trials will be held Saturday morning, June 10<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday afternoon, June 14<sup>th</sup>. "A" meets will be held on five consecutive Saturdays beginning on June 17<sup>th</sup>. We will also be participating in four "B" meets, beginning on Wednesday, June 21<sup>st</sup>. The Stingrays end of season party will be Saturday, July 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Regular swim team meet season runs from May 30<sup>th</sup> to July 14<sup>th</sup> plus MCSL Divisional Championships, for those who qualify, on July 22<sup>nd</sup>. Other important MCSL dates are as follows: Divisional Relay Carnival will be held on a date TBA between June 25<sup>th</sup> and July 9<sup>th</sup>. The Coaches Invitational Long Course Meet will be held on July 11<sup>th</sup>, the All Stars Relay meet will be held on July 29<sup>th</sup> and the All Stars Individual meet will be held on July 30<sup>th</sup>. Only team members who qualify for Divisionals will practice from July 17<sup>th</sup> through July 21<sup>st</sup> and All Star participants will have special practices from July 24<sup>th</sup> through July 28<sup>th</sup>. Please keep these dates in mind as you make your summer plans.

Swim team registration will begin in April 2017 and end on Friday, May 26, 2017. All swim-team registration, for pre-team and team swimmers, must be done on-line at our team website, [www.ccrastingrays.com](http://www.ccrastingrays.com).
